

Outback Roundup 2005

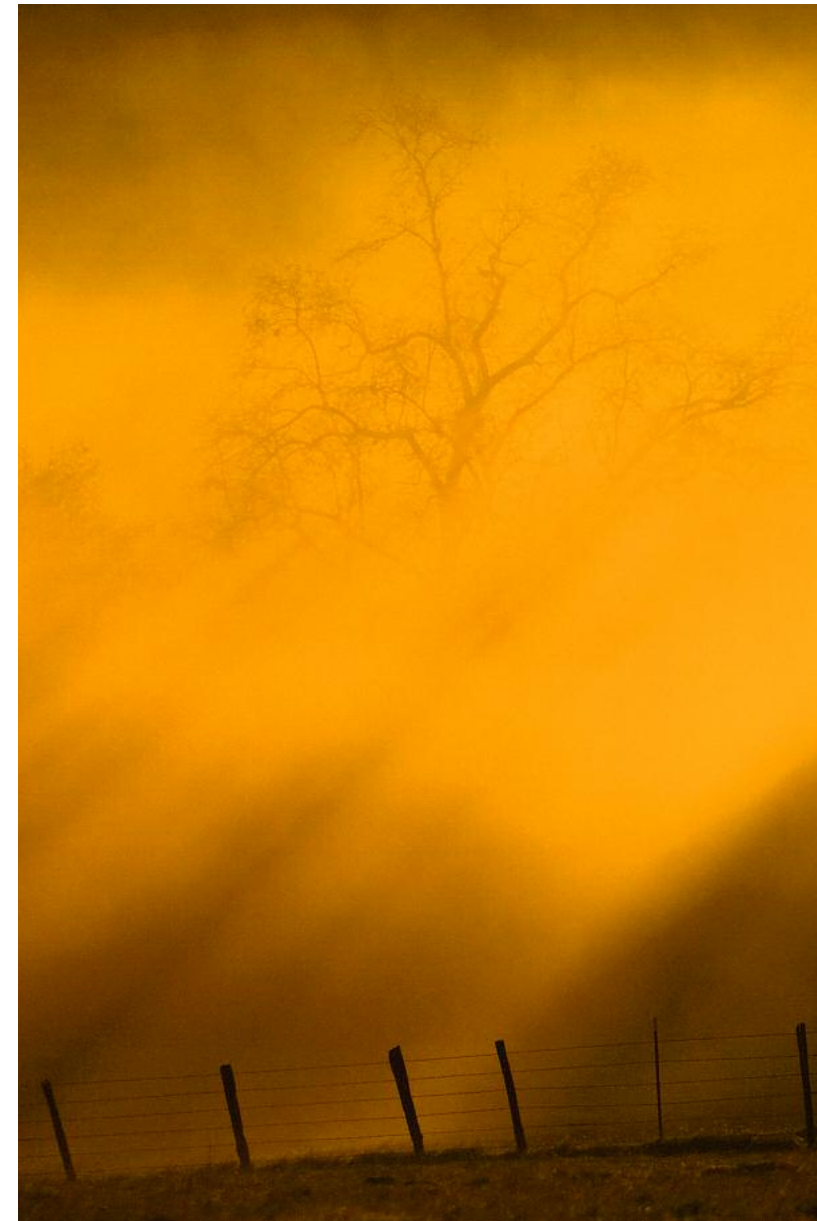

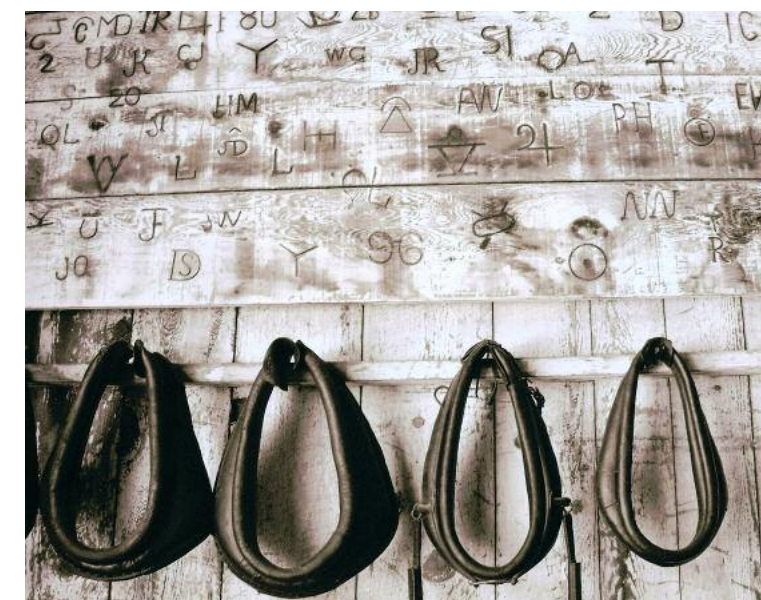
Anyway...keep up the good work. It's always a pleasure to see the beautiful and touching photos submitted.—Marilyn Newton

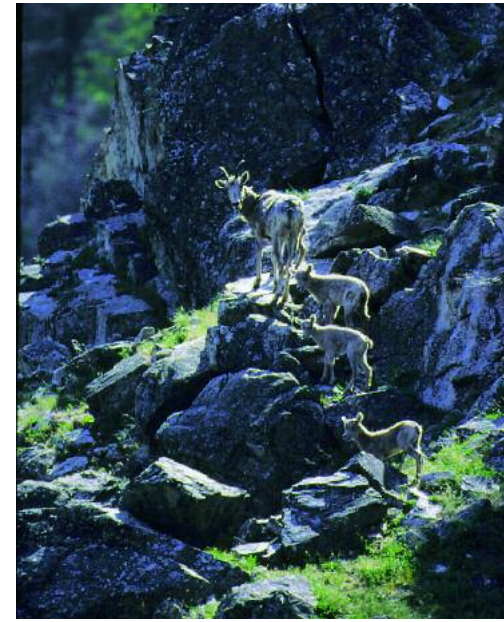

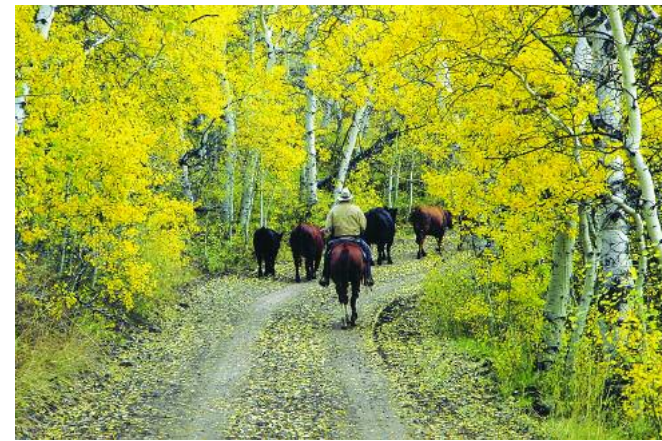

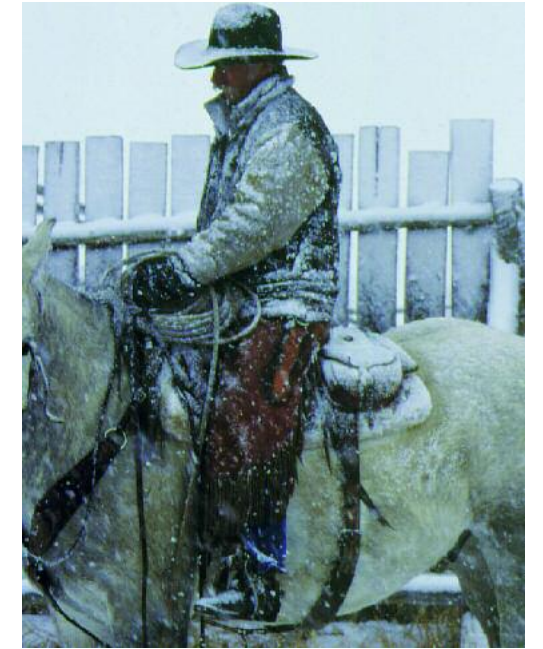
